Description: Photos pack to encourage children to look beyond the stereotypes of developing countries. Useful for global citizenship so that children can become aware that the world extends beyond their own locality.

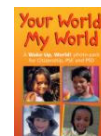

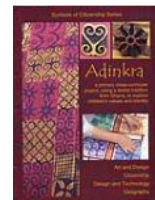
